**S** In the evening, as winter darkness begins, we gather in the quiet church, with candles lit from the Peace Light originating from the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem, to hear the prophecies and great music of Advent including selections by George F. Handel, Gustav Holst, Paul Manz, John Ferguson and Steven Warner. Based on the traditional service from Kings College, Cambridge, Christ the King parish adds its own touch, with readers of all ages and music led by the adult choir and junior schola, cantors, handbell ringers and instrumentalists. The assembly is as much a part of this service as the choirs and joins in singing the great hymns of Advent. Join us as we share the Peace Light, a symbol of the meaning of Christmas and the wish for peace and forgiveness among all human beings.
