The Peace Light from Bethlehem is a continuously-burning flame, originating from the Grotto of the Nativity in Bethlehem, Israel. Each December Scouts around the world are challenged to help the flame reach as many people as possible, while reminding the public that we can all be channels of peace through our words and actions.

For the third year in a row, local Boy Scouts will be offering the Peace Light flame to the public in a brief and meaningful ceremony at Bedford Presbyterian Church.

To receive the Peace Light flame on December 15:

- **Bring your own oil lantern (preferable) or enclosed candle.**
- **Arrive at the church *any time* between 6pm and 8pm.**
- **Make plans for sharing the flame! You are invited to keep your own flame burning as long/short as you'd like, but please share it with at least one other person before extinguishing your own flame.**
- **Invite your friends and neighbors. Please help spread the word!**
- **All Scouts and leaders are asked to wear their uniforms.**
